

Procedure for appointing a relevant person.

The Relevant person is defined in the Children First Act 2015 as “ a person who is appointed by a provider of a relevant service to be the first point of contact in respect of the provider’s Child Safeguarding Statement”.

At the first meeting of the RCBS committee, following the AGM in September, the RCBS committee will appoint a relevant person, by nomination and election. This person may be the Child Protection Officer.
